



Use of Open Government Data

In the context of the digital transformation of Brazilian public management, this **questionnaire aims to obtain an overview of the use of Open Government Data (DGA) in the public administrations of the States and the Federal District**. More specifically, understand if, how, and why DGAs are used. According to [Open Definition](#), open data is one that anyone can access, use, modify and share for any purpose. Open Government Data (DGA) is made available by public entities in a machine-readable format, freely accessible for reuse for any purpose, and under an open license for use and reuse in the public and private domains. The research is being developed by the University of Minho (UM) and the University of the United Nations (UNU-EGOV), with the support of the Working Group for Digital Transformation of the State and District Governments of Brazil ([GTD.GOV](#)) linked to the National Council of Secretaries of State of Administration (CONSAD) and the Brazilian Association of State ICT Entities (ABEP-TIC).

The answers given throughout the questionnaire will be kept confidential, being only known by the elements of the intervening entities UM, UNU-EGOV, and GTD.GOV who are part of the work team involved in conducting the study.
